## **Monde Nissin Australia**

## **Hire Equipment Terms and Conditions**

## Commencement Date: 1st March 2024

All Monde Nissin Australia Suppliers and Transport companies, who are transferring CHEP and Loscam wooden pallets must read and be aware of the new Hire Equipment Trading Terms and Conditions, as outlined in this document effective 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024. Transferring Hire Equipment to Monde Nissin Australia after 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024 is an acceptance and acknowledgment of these Hire Equipment terms and conditions further to the standard CHEP and Loscam hire terms.

## **Dockets**

- 1. All Wooden Pallet transfers must have the Monde Nissin Australia Purchase Order number recorded in the Reference section #1 of the docket.
- 2. Wooden Pallet transfers must be raised to the correct Monde Nissin Australia site. Pallet Transfer dockets will be rejected without notice.
- 3. Wooden Pallet transfers must have a 7-day delay from the receiving date. Pallet transfer dockets will be corrected without notice unless contracted otherwise.
- Goods Receipts and Transport Con Notes will NOT be accepted as a hire equipment transfer POD.
  Only Monde Nissin Australia stamped CHEP or Loscam Pallet Transfer equipment transfers will be accepted.
- 5. Strictly **NO EXCHANGE** pallets.
- 6. Wooden Pallets delivered to Monde Nissin Australia sites without a Hire Equipment Transfer will receive a Monde Nissin Australia manual docket for the sender to process. If this is not processed within 90 days this Pallet transfer docket will be void.
  - Please note: Consistent failure to supply a Pallet Hire Transfer docket, will revoke this clause 6 and will not apply.
- 7. Monde Nissin Australia will allow 7 business days for the trading partner to supply a POD. The POD must contain a stamped CHEP or Loscam Pallet Hire Equipment transfer docket. Failure to supply this docket, will result in the Pallet Transfer being rejected.
- 8. Any transfers over 180 days will not be investigated.
- 9. Any unprocessed transfers over 90 days will be corrected to the current date.
- 10. Wooden pallets not meeting the agreed CHEP or Loscam pallet standards, contaminated or damaged, will not be accepted at any Monde Nissin Australia site.
